

A. Received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. Written statements from Vet explaining the reasons for being bolstered within 180 days MAY be accepted. IN NO CASES MAY THE BOOSTER BE OUTSIDE OF 180 DAYS. Horses not in compliance with this rule will be denied entry to the competition grounds upon request by Management.

B. Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.

C. Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. Vaccination record showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within 180 days).

Dear Competitor,

We would like to invite you to participate in the Colorado CDE & CT September 22-24. Entries open June 2 and close September 8.

Our judges are Lisa Singer and Teresa Bron with Carrie Ostrowski-Place as TD.

The marathon course will include new areas of the park and is over grassy rolling terrain with some areas of sand.

In addition to the combined driving event itself, we are also offering a combined test of just dressage & cones. You can choose to enter either or both events. If horse AND driver are participation in both the CDE and the CT (requires two separate entry forms) in the SAME division, the dressage test will be driven once to count for both events, and two separate cones tests.

The competition will be held at the Colorado Horse Park, (CHP) in Parker, Colorado. We will be using the large arena in the main area of the park for dressage and cones. The arena footing is a mix of GGT (German Geo Textile) and sand, and is firm but resilient.

Driver/grooms will be permitted twice around on marathon per ADS Rule-book article 943.2 if scheduling permits. No horse, driver, navigator, or equipment may go more than twice in any course/test. Please include this information and notes on equipment sharing with your entry form.

Food will be available on the grounds or from many local restaurants. There are several hotels in the area. If you plan on camping in an RV or horse trailer, please fill out and submit the CHP RV reservation form. The form tells you to send it directly to CHP, but we ask that you also include a copy of the form with your event entry form. (Please note that CHP has two RV reservation forms, one for general horse shows and one specifically for our combined driving event.)

This Colorado adventure promises to be both fun and challenging. We look forward to seeing you here!
