Ladies and Gentlemen,

We will host the Sporting Day of Traditional Driving on Saturday, May 30 at La Bastide Estate in Larkspur. The rain date will be Sunday, May 31. If Sunday is not required as a rain date, our judge will hold a Pleasure driving clinic. Our judge/commentator this year will be Mr. Robert Longstaff of Stuart, Florida.

New this year, we will have a wine & cheese gathering on Friday, May 29 at 5 pm to see the new facility. This will give everyone a chance to socialize, receive the competitor briefing and competitor packets and thank the volunteers making this event possible. If you're not able to attend, competitor packets will be available upon arrival. There is stabling available in the area at Sandy Clayton's and Erik Jensen's. For the safety of all our equines, a negative Coggins test within past year and EHV 1 & 4 (flu/rhino) vaccination.

Schedule of events:

- 10:30 am: Presentation
- 10:45 am: Pleasure drive around beautiful neighborhood, including four basic driving tests.
- 12:15 pm: Skilled driving test (cones)
- 2:00 pm: A light lunch and beverages will be provided in the courtyard.
- 3:00 pm: Ribbons and embroidered items will be awarded. A slideshow of each entry with commentary on the turnouts presented by Mr. Longstaff.

All participants must be members of the Colorado Driving Society. A single membership is \$30 and a family is \$35. The entry fee is \$75. Lunch will be \$35, and we welcome donations toward volunteer lunches, if you so desire. Sunday Pleasure Driving Clinic is \$50.

Except when preparing the vehicles and horses, we request that our dress code be observed at all times throughout the grounds. Gentlemen: coat, slacks, tie, hat, and gloves; Ladies: a dress, long skirt or slacks and blouse, jacket, hat, and gloves.

Grooms may be in formal or informal livery as fits the vehicle and turnout. A guest may serve as groom on appropriate vehicles. Whips must carry a whip and wear an appropriate driving apron. All volunteers and non-riding guests should dress in similar fashion.

This event is open to all equines. If possible, we encourage original traditional antique vehicles (built before 1945) or reproductions. No wire wheels or pneumatic tires are allowed. Be sure to remember your number holders.

All whips, grooms, volunteers and guests are asked to sign the release on the next page, as well as the Wiedenhues release.

The skilled driving test (cones) will be driven at a trot and judged on time and balls down. Please include the track width measured from the outside of your rear wheels on the entry form.

The course for the pleasure drive will include an “out and back” so that we will have the pleasure of passing and saluting each other, and an opportunity to appreciate the other turnouts. We will again have the ever-popular beer and champagne stops.

It is our intention to make this event as inclusive as possible while observing the traditional standards of classical carriage driving. We wish this to be a fun and educational day celebrating our carriages, our horses and our very special lifestyle. We look forward to seeing all of you.
