

2. Statement of Health/Veterinary Health Certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at CHP, documenting that the horse has:

A. Received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with the most recent booster being within 180 days. Written statements from Vet explaining the reasons for being bolstered within 180 days MAY be accepted. IN NO CASES MAY THE BOOSTER BE OUTSIDE OF 180 DAYS. Horses not in compliance with this rule will be denied entry to the competition grounds upon request by Management.

B. Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days.

C. Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. Vaccination record showing date of vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (booster must be within 180 days).

D. The following statement must be included on the health certificate: "I have examined the animal(s) represented on this certificate of veterinary inspection and have found no clinical signs of vesicular stomatitis and they have not originated from a premises under quarantine for vesicular stomatitis."

Dear Competitor,

We would like to invite you to participate in the Colorado CDE & CT, August 21-23. Entries open May 1 and close August 10.

Our judges are Lynn Legg and Hardy Zantke, with Jim Thomas as TD.

The marathon course, designed by Bruce Ettenger will include up to 7 obstacles through partly wooded trails, over grassy rolling terrain with some areas of sand and a water obstacle.

A **controlled warm-up** has been added instead of Section A. This format change is in keeping with other national level competitions. Training, Preliminary, Intermediate and Advanced/Intermediate AI for the CDE & CT divisions.

The competition will be held at the Colorado Horse Park, (CHP) in Parker, Colorado. We will be using the large arena in the main area of the park for dressage and cones. The arena footing is a mix of GGT (German Geo Textile) and sand, and is firm but resilient.

Driver/grooms will be permitted twice around on marathon per ADS Rule-book article 943.2 if scheduling permits. No horse, driver, navigator, or equipment may go more than twice in any course/test. Please include sharing information your entry form.

Food will be available on the grounds and from many local restaurants. There are several hotels in the area. If you plan on camping in an RV or horse trailer, please fill out and submit the CHP RV reservation form. The form tells you to send it directly to CHP, but we ask that you also include a copy of the form with your event entry form.

This Colorado adventure promises to be both fun and challenging. We look forward to seeing you here!
