

Veterinary/health requirements:

Horses: Current negative Coggins
Vaccination records showing dates of Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 required (booster must be within 180 days).
WNV, WEE, EEE, Tetanus and Rabies vaccinations are strongly recommended.
Health certificate issued within 10 days of arriving at venue
No unloading of horses from trailers prior to biosecurity check on arrival

People: Adherence to current ADS and state/local Covid-19 guidelines. (Please check prior to arrival)

Stabling:

On-site in permanent stalls.
Initial bedding of 4 bags of shavings required; bring your own or order from us. This CHP requirement is to prevent hole pawing.
CT competitors may haul-in Friday morning with a \$25 fee or stable Thursday evening for a \$35 fee.

- ◆ It's a great training opportunity for the Combined Test competitors who may drive section A, after the completion of the Marathon on Saturday.
- ◆ Clinic option on Monday, October 4, with Lisa Singer.

Dear Competitor,

We would like to invite you to participate in the Colorado CDE & CT October 1-3. Entries open May 14 and close September 3.

Our judges are Hardy Zantke and Lisa Singer. Lisa will be offering a clinic on the Monday following the event.

The cones and marathon courses have been designed by Richard Nicoll, who also helped design some of our new obstacles. The marathon course will include new areas of the park and is over grassy terrain with some areas of sand.

In addition to the combined driving event itself, we are also offering a combined test – with options. You can choose to enter either or both events. If you choose to enter both the CDE and the CT, you have a choice of having a single test count towards both events, or you can drive your test twice – once for each event.

The competition will again be held at the Colorado Horse Park, but this year we will be using the large arena in the main area of the park for dressage and cones, instead of holding those competitions on the marathon field. The arena footing is a mix of GTT (German Geo Textile) and sand, and is firm but resilient.

Driver/grooms will be permitted twice around on marathon per ADS Rule-book article 943.2 if scheduling permits. Please include this information and notes on equipment sharing with your entry form.

Food will be available on the grounds or from many local restaurants. There are several hotels in the area. If you plan on camping in an RV or horse trailer, please fill out and submit the CHP RV reservation form. The form tells you to send it directly to CHP, but we ask that you also include a copy of the form with your event entry form. (Please note that CHP has two RV reservation forms, one for general horse shows and one specifically for our combined driving event.)

This Colorado adventure promises to be both fun and challenging. We look forward to seeing you here!

Entries: CDE \$225, CT \$175 or (\$125 if entering both CDE & CT)
Late entry fee: \$50
Lisa Singer clinic: \$100/45 minutes, separate check (Limited availability; slots filled in order of postmarked entry. Please submit separate check in case clinic is full and we need to refund your payment for the clinic.)
Stabling \$130, Thursday-Saturday nights. \$35/night
Stall cleaning deposit: \$25, separate check (refunded if stalls are stripped)
ADS competition fee: \$5
ADS nonmember fee: \$35
Welcome party, Thursday night: Free
Competitor dinner, Saturday night: \$30
Loose dog fee: \$100 per occurrence
Biosecurity fee: \$50 for unloading horse from trailer prior to biosecurity check
