Additional Considerations/Comments - Drivers/navigators or any equipment sharing (i.e. carriages) are allowed a maximum of 2 times on the marathon, according to Article 943.2, as long as scheduling permits and the entries are in a different division. Competitors must say on their entry form what they are sharing and who it is being shared with in order to be accommodated in the schedule. If the sharing is not indicated on the entry form- a \$50 sharing charge will be assessed if the sharing can be accommodated. There will be no sharing changes made after the closing date without an additional \$50 fee. The course examination may be made on foot, or in golf carts only; no other motorized vehicles. VSE - no hyperbikes. VSE marathon sections may be shorter. The organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry or sharing accommodation, and to combine or cancel any classes.

Directions to Show - Directions: FROM INTERSTATE 25: Turn east on Colorado 470 (tolls) or Lincoln Avenue (no tolls) about 4 miles to Route 83, also known as Parker Road. Go south through the town of Parker. Continue to Bayou Gulch Road and turn left past Ponderosa High School. Show entrance will be located on your left. FROM INTERSTATE 70 EASTBOUND: Take Colorado 470 (tolls) until you reach Route 83 or Parker Road. Go south through the town of Parker. Continue to Bayou Gulch Road and turn left past Ponderosa High School. Show entrance

will be located on your left. FROM INTERSTATE 70 WESTBOUND: Turn west onto Route 86, just west of Limon. Continue towards Franktown intersection and turn north (right) onto Route 83 or Parker Road. Travel approximately three miles and turn right on Bayou Gulch Road. The show entrance will be located on your left. FOR TRAILER PARKING, turn onto Bayou Gulch from Parker Road heading south.

#### Other Information

Colorado Horse Park requires the following for all equines on the property: (1) Negative Coggins within a year of show date. (2) Current vaccination against WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus. Rabies is strongly recommended. (3) Statement of Health/Veterinary Health Certificate dated within 10 days of arrival. Health certificate will document that the horse has: (a) received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 180 days; (b) not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV 4/1 within the past 28 days; (c) not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV 4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV 4/1 within the past 28 days. All horses will be subject to a bio-security check before being unloaded from their trailers. Please include copies of Coggins and vaccination record with entry as well as having copies available for veterinarian on arrival. IF YOU UNLOAD YOUR HORSE PRIOR TO BIO-CHECK THERE WILL BE A \$50 FEE.
