Ladies and Gentlemen,

We will host our Sporting Day of Traditional Driving on Saturday, 19 September at Thistle Hill Farm in Franktown. The rain date will be Sunday, 20 September. If Sunday is not required as a rain date, we will host a relatively aggressive cross-country drive on that date.

Our judge this year will be Mr. J R Blumenthal of Timnath, Colorado. He is a longtime exhibitor and international judge of Friesian horses.

Schedule of events:

- 10:30 am: Presentation
 - 10:45 am: Pleasure drive (5.5 to 7.5 miles), including three basic driving tests.
 - 12:15 pm: Skilled driving test (cones)
 - 2:00 pm: Exhibitors will provide their own lunch to be consumed in the carriage parking area or on outdoor tables in the courtyard.
 - 3:00 pm: Mr. Blumenthal will offer commentary on the turn outs.
- All participants must be members of the Colorado Driving Society. A single membership is \$30 and a family is \$35.

The entry fee is \$40. You are welcome to bring your lunch and libations and picnic on the grounds.

Except when preparing the vehicles and horses, we request that our dress code be observed at all times throughout the grounds. Gentlemen: coat, slacks, tie, hat, and gloves; Ladies: a dress, long skirt or slacks and blouse, jacket, hat, and gloves. Grooms may be in formal or informal livery as fits the vehicle and turnout. A guest may



serve as groom on appropriate vehicles. Whips must carry a whip and wear an appropriate driving apron. All volunteers and non-riding guests will dress in similar fashion.

This event is open to horses, mules, and ponies only.

Be sure to remember your number holders.

All whips, grooms, volunteers and guests are asked to sign the release on the next page, as well as the Jensen's release upon arrival.

The skilled driving test (cones) will be driven at a trot and judged on time and balls down. Please include the track width measured from the outside of your rear wheels on the entry form.

The course for the pleasure drive will include an "out and back" so that we will have the pleasure of passing and saluting each other, and an opportunity to appreciate the other turnouts. We will again have the ever-popular beer and champagne stops.

All persons on the grounds will observe social distancing and wear a mask whenever possible.

It is our intention to make this event as inclusive as possible while observing the traditional standards of classical carriage driving. We wish this to be a fun and educational day celebrating our carriages, our horses and our very special lifestyle. We look forward to seeing all of you.

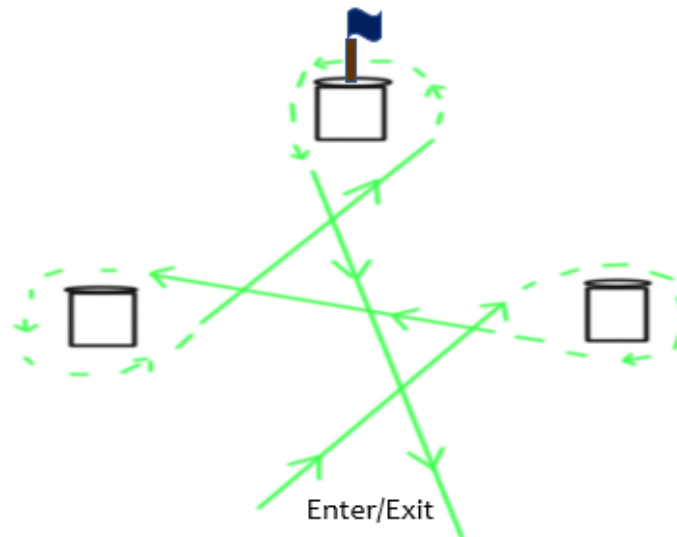

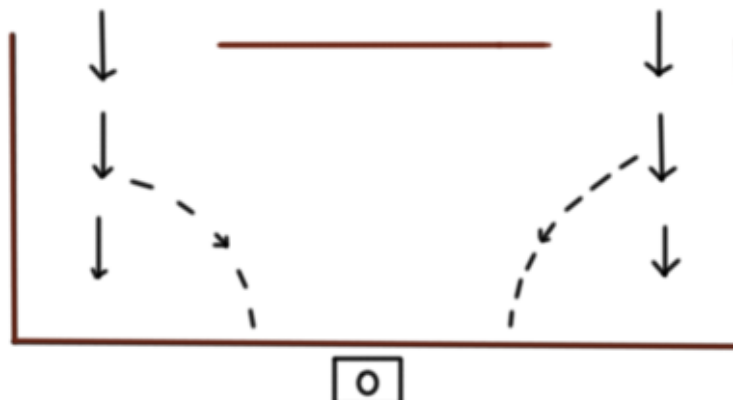
Flag Cloverleaf

3 barrels are placed in a triangle formation. You will drive a standard barrel pattern (cloverleaf) circling to either the right or left to start, and while circling the last barrel you must place the flag in the bucket on the barrel. Fastest time, while not knocking down any barrels and successfully placing the flag in bucket wins. Knocking a barrel over- 5 second penalty, flag not in bucket - 10 seconds added to time, incorrect cloverleaf pattern is no score.



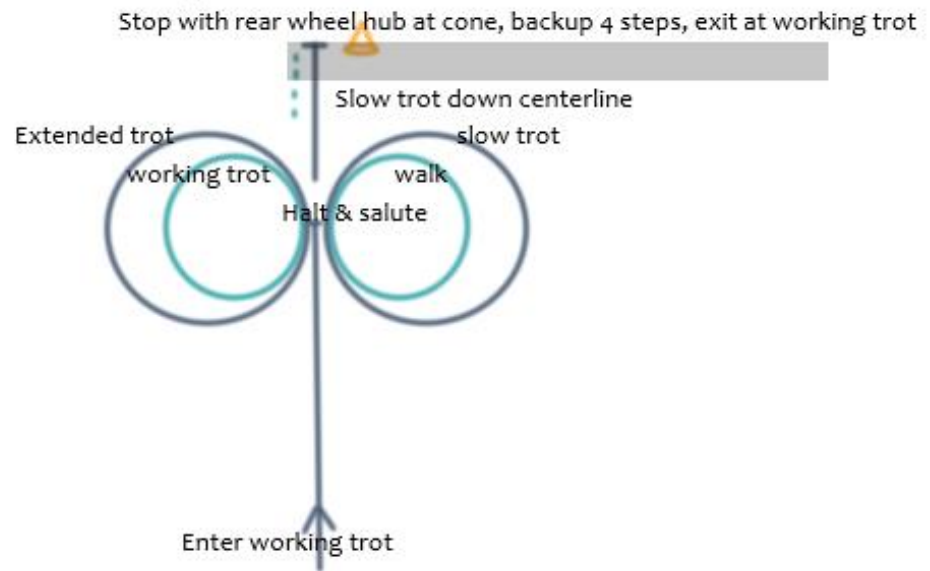
Dock, Deliver, Depart

Remembering the days of wagon deliveries, this event is intended to test your skills of backing, side passing, and quickness. Choose your best side (right or left), back into the chute (10 points), side pass 90 degrees (10 points), drop off basket (10 points) and depart to exit without knocking any of the boards (5 seconds added for knocking boundary boards out of place). Fastest time and points are calculated to determine the winner.



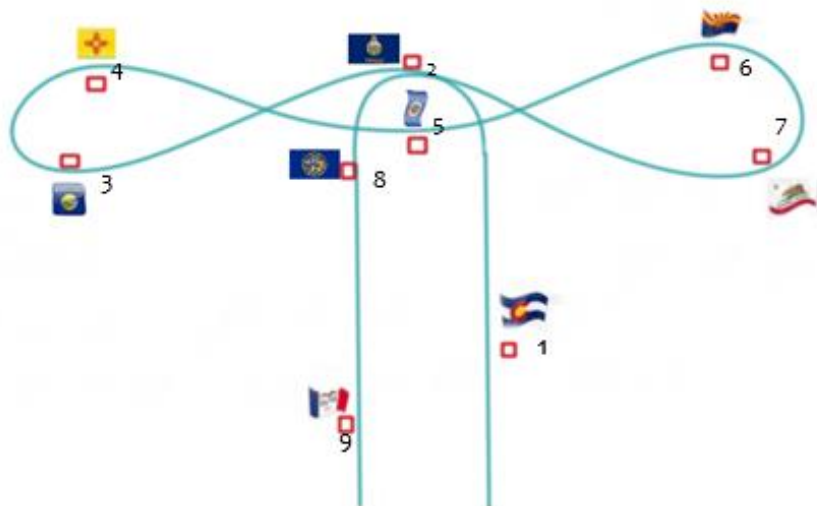
Double OO's

This class will test your reinsmanship skills. Enter the ring at a working trot (10 points), drive to center of circles, halt & salute the judge (10 points). Start the smaller circle on your right at a walk (10 points), followed by a slow trot for the larger circle on the right (10 points). As you finish that large circle, start the small circle on the left at a working trot (10 points), then start a large circle on the left at an extended trot (10 points). Once complete, drive down centerline at a slow trot (10 points), stop at the cone in line with your rear wheel hub (10 points). Back 4 steps (10 points), then exit at a working trot (10 points). 100 possible points, if not completed correctly, 0 points awarded per section.



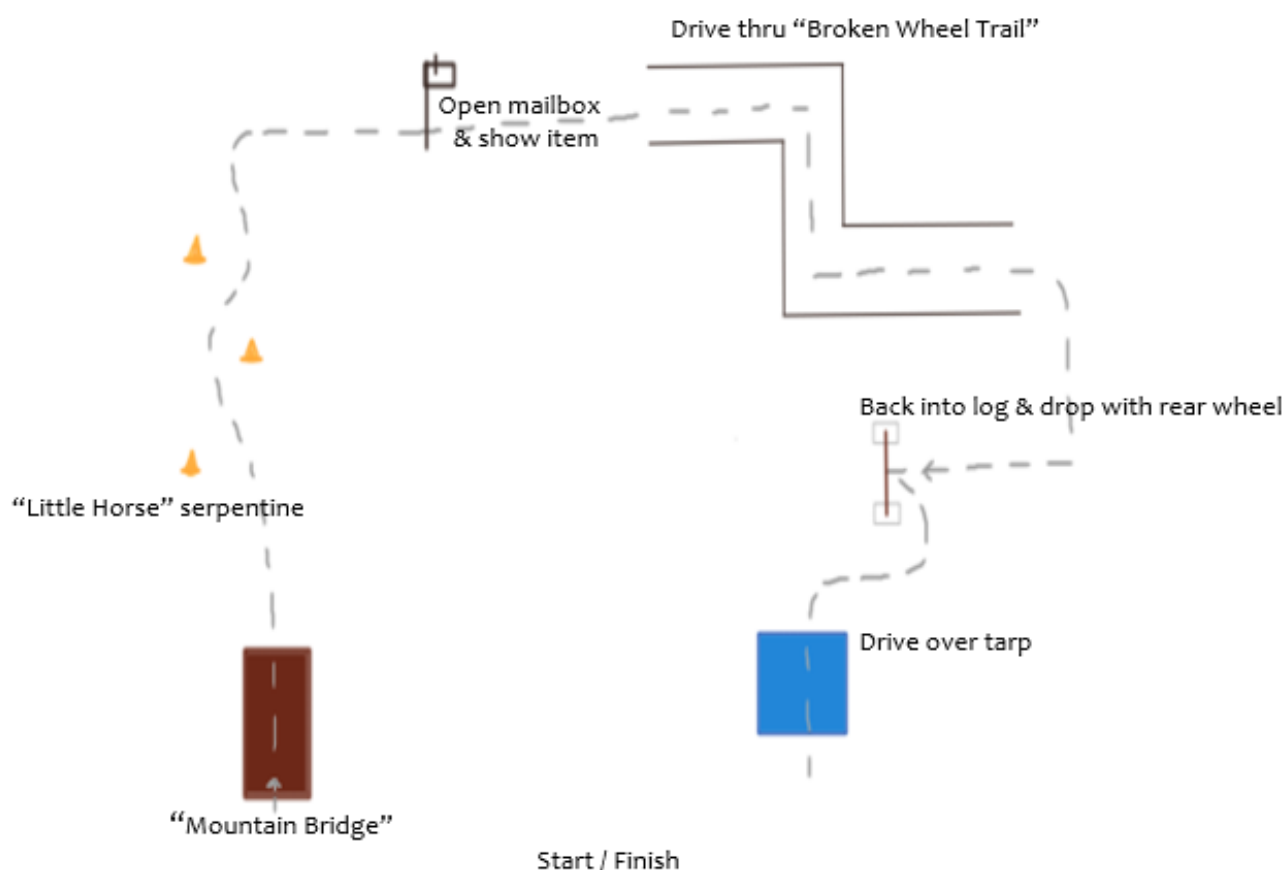
Race through the States

Drive the marked course lined with flags from Colorado, Kansas, Montana, New Mexico, Minnesota, Arizona, California, Nebraska & Iowa. Best time wins, it's colorful & unique!



Over Hill & Dale

Follow the trail over the mountain bridge, through the little horse serpentine, to the mailbox where you'll open & show the item, drive through the broken wheel trail pipe lined path, back up and use your carriage wheels to drop the wooden rail from the cinderblocks, then cross the tarp and head to the finish. Obstacles are worth 30 points each, 10 points are subtracted for each refusal, after 3 refusals, you must move on. Time will be used as the tie breaker.



Final note: Blue Jeans are the expected attire, so no lap robe is necessary. Helmets are strongly encouraged & required if you're under 18 years old. A groom is required, if you're driving multiples. Your equines gate is up to you ... walk, trot or canter. If cantering, you must maintain control, with safety as the ultimate goal. The classes will run concurrently, to minimize any wait time and allow you to continue driving from one game course to another. We normally conclude around noon, enjoy lunch together (social distancing this year), give out awards, pack up & head home.

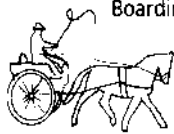

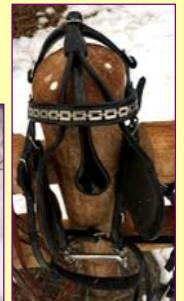

 - Three months before your event, submit a budget to the CDS board of directors through the event coordinator. *No publicity for an event will be released until the budget has been approved.*
 - Once your budget is approved, please submit a description of the event to the newsletter editor. Include event title, location, date, time, rain date, fees, organizer, details of the event, closing date for entries & where to send entry form and fee. (Please send content with minimal formatting. We'll take care of the layout.)
 - For help recruiting volunteers, contact the volunteer coordinator (below) two months prior to the event with a list of the positions to be filled (set-up, scribe, timer, cone setters, volunteer judges, announcer, photographer, etc.)
 - Arrange for a volunteer to take photographs or contact the newsletter editor about photographs.
 - After your event, please send a report about scores, awards, number of entries, etc. to the newsletter editor.
 - To be reimbursed by the club for any expenses you incur, you must provide a receipt and a CDS reimbursement form, available from the event coordinator.
- Items that are donated require a receipt for the value of the item and the word "Donated" written on the receipt for tax purposes. This can include a judge's fee if the judge normally charges but chooses to donate the service to CDS.
